# Serious Adverse Event Review (SAER) Education Learning Pathway

The SAER Education Learning Pathway has been developed to ensure NSW Health staff are suitably equipped and competent to understand and participate on SAER teams. The pathway builds staff capability in SAERs from the Foundational to the Advanced level in line with the Healthcare Safety and Quality Capability Set (Clinical Excellence Commission, 2020). Undertaking the SAER education learning pathway ensures that learning is targeted to the appropriate level and helps minimise repetition of content. Participants are required to complete each stage of the pathway before progressing to the next educational stage.
