What parts of the building blocks are we doing well on our ward? What elements of the building blocks can we improve?	Staff identify areas that are not reliably done on their ward e.g. safety huddles - every shift every day. (go to video at 3:15mins or slide 6 to help identify components for improvement)	3 minutes	Facilitated group discussion
